(Outline and Purpose of the Course)

- ・CEFR C1~C2を目指す人のためのクラスです。
- ・「読む」・「書く」・「聞く」・「話す」の4技能についての総合的な日本語能力の向上をめざします。
- ・日本語で行われる専門科目を理解するための準備もします。
- •This class is designed for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels.
- The purpose of this course is for students to develop their overall Japanese language skills, focusing on reading, writing, listening and conversation.
- This course is also designed to prepare students to understand specialized courses conducted in Japanese.

(Course Goals)

The Japanese language classes for Kyoto iUP students consist of two types:

(1) Japanese language courses exclusive to Kyoto iUP: These classes are designed for Kyoto iUP students.

Classes are offered according to the needs of the students.

(2) Japanese language courses in the ILAS: These classes are designed for students to study together with other international students. You will have the opportunity to communicate with many people in Japanese.

(1) Vocabulary & Reading exclusive to iUP students (SASAKI)

これは、CEFR C1~C2を目指す人または達成した人のための語彙・読解クラスです。

さまざまな文章を読みながら、大学で学ぶ上で重要になる語彙(学術共通語彙、専門用語)を習得し、日本語で 専門科目を受けるためのカ(読むカ、書くカ、話すカ)を身につけます。クラスでは850語以上を学び、クラス修了 時までに、2,500語以上の語彙が使えるようになることをめざします。

This is a vocabulary and reading class for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels or higher. The purpose of the course is for students to acquire vocabulary (Japanese Common Academic Words & Technical Term) that will be important for university study and acquire the skills (reading, writing, and speaking) to take specialized courses conducted in Japanese through reading a variety of texts. The vocabulary you will study in the course is more than 850 words. The total vocabulary we want you to learn by the end of the course will be more than 2,500 words, including those learned up to the Intermediate

II level.

2Conversation (YUKAWA)

これは、CEFR C1~C2を目指す人または達成した人のための会話クラスです。学習・研究活動を行ううえで必要となる会話能力を習得することをめざします。

This is a grammar class for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels or higher. The purpose of the course is for students to develop conversation skills for study in Japan.

③Listening (NAKASHIMA)

これは、CEFR C1~C2を目指す人または達成した人のための聴解クラスです。日常的な会話や教養的内容の説明などを教材としてポイントとなる語や文脈の理解および全体の意味の把握、さらに、詳細についての正確な聞きとりが可能になることをめざします。

This is a listening class for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels or higher. The purpose of the class is for students to improve their listening comprehension abilities by carefully listening to lectures on cultural content and audio recordings of daily conversations.

4 Composition exclusive to iUP students (SASAKI)

これは、CEFR C1~C2を目指す人または達成した人のための作文クラスです。自分の伝えたい内容が読み手に伝わるよう、わかりやすい文章を書く練習をします。また、時事的なこと、やや専門的なことについて、さまざまな表現を適切に用い、説得力のある文章を書く練習もします。1,500-2,000字程度の文章を書けるようになることをめざします。

This is a composition class for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels or higher. This course will provide students with practice in writing clear sentences so that the reader can understand what they are trying to express. The course also provides practice in writing about current topics and somewhat specialized topics, using a variety of appropriate expressions to write effectively and compellingly. By the end of this course, students will be able to write sentences in 1,500 to 2,000 characters.

⑤Reading (NAMBA)

これは、CEFR C1~C2を目指す人または達成した人のための読解クラスです。身のまわりの文書から学術的な文章まで、幅広い読解力を養うことをめざします。

This is a reading class for students who are working towards attaining a level of proficiency equivalent to CEFR C1~C2 levels or higher. The purpose of this course is for students to cultivate a broad range of reading comprehension, through reading documents and academic text.
